- The Council will be ordering the new play-ground for installation after the Summer holidays so the children can still access the play area during the Summer.
- The Councillors have met 3 times this month, at a Full Council Meeting & 2 Committee Meetings. The Agendas for Council & Committee Meetings are displayed in the notice board outside the Council Office a week before each meeting. The Council have agreed to replace the 2 wooden benches on Lion Quay with steel ones and use the slats from the old ones to repair those broken on Pearson's Quay & at the recreation ground.
- The Council are starting the introduction of the Edible Garden Project at the green on the junction of Heath Rd & Rectory Rd.
- The Council are working closely with the Football Club to the benefit of Parishioners and have bought a Lawn Mower that will be used to maintain the Recreation ground for sport and community usage.
